

Landscape Committee

March 28, 2017 - Meeting Minutes

1. Mulch for Phases #3,#4,# – Mulching will likely occur in mid- April) or mid-May, as scheduled permits. Established evergreens will receive light mulch to minimize mold or disease conditions.
2. Replacement evergreen trees – two evergreen trees were lost in late 2016; two new 10.ft. evergreen replacement trees will be planted in late April or early May. The locations are: Greenwood/Gray Oak/sidewalk, Racette/Oak Meadow Cove. Mulching will need to be done by the Landscape Committee.
3. Replacement Deciduous trees – In April BrightView will be replacing two deciduous trees damaged by weed trimmers in 2016. There is no cost to Association.
4. Modification of Evergreen Management Program – The Landscape Chair reviewed the proposed modification of the Evergreen Management Program to permit a change in the program from needle cast prevention spray to a more direct, economical program of fertilizing evergreens – to strengthen evergreens and improve disease resistance. The landscape committee unanimously approved the modification, and recommended the management program be modified to an alternating program of spraying one year, and & fertilizing the next year. This recommended will be presented to the association board.
5. Landscape Committee members will be volunteering to trim selected, established evergreen trees located in Phase 1 & #2. Committee members will also be mulching two new evergreens, and also be involved in the annual volunteer Annual Flower Planting day to be held in early May.
